

Artists Instructions Art on the Avenue

Thanks for participating in the Paint Annapolis Art on the Avenue.

You MUST check in at Circle Gallery on Wednesday, June 6 between 11 am and 7 pm or Thursday after 10 am. If you have not prepaid for this event, you may pay your \$20 fee when you register.

You will need to get your painting surface stamped at Circle Gallery before you begin.

You may begin painting at daybreak on June 7. Your painting MUST be completed within the area defined on the Art on the Avenue map (Annapolis historic district).

Jurying and sales begins at 5:30 pm on Maryland Avenue. Look for Paint Annapolis staff for instructions on where to set up. All sales must be made by Paint Annapolis staff and Circle Gallery retains 40% of sales.

Paint Annapolis juried artists may bring their work to Circle Gallery on Friday, June 8, as one of their three pieces for jurying and exhibition or to 186 Main St as one of their three additional pieces offered for sale. The work must be framed and wired.

Public artists may take any work not sold to West Annapolis Artwork and Fine Framing, 4 Annapolis St. on Friday, June 8, between 11 am and 4 pm. The work will hang there for a month-long exhibition of work by local plein air artists.
