ENTRY

Light and Shadow may be entered by uploading JPEG images through MFA's online entry system. Go to www. mdfedart.org for details. MFA does not display Watermarks; artists display at their own risk.

- Works previously viewed in a juried exhibition on Curve Gallery are not eligible.
- Artist must submit 1 JPEG image per artwork and may also submit 1 additional JPEG as a detail. To provide the best images for juror set pixel dimension to around 2000 pixels on the longest side. File size may be no more than 2 MB.
- Payments must be processed through PayPal.
- A maximum of 6 original works created within the past 3 years may be entered. 1 or 2 entries \$35 (MFA members \$20). Additional four entries \$5 each. Work may be priced for sale or POR. Entry fees are non-refundable. Membership, if desired, may be immediately processed before entry.
- If artwork is part of a limited edition, please state total number in the edition.

From Caravaggio to Monet to Ansel Adams, artists use their talents and tools to capture rich shadows, bright highlights and their many subtleties. Any original 2-D or 3-D artwork depicting light and shadow will be considered by the juror. Entries are open to all artists. This MFA exhibition will display selected works in the online Curve Gallery from Dec 15 through Jan. 30, 2019. Show Chairs: Richard Niewerth and Wil Scott.

JUROR: Peter Van Dyck studied painting and drawing at the Florence Academy of Art in Florence, Italy from 1998-2002 and also taught in the program from 2000-2002. He returned to Philadelphia in 2002 to paint in his own studio and began exhibiting his work in numerous group shows in Philadelphia, New York and San Francisco. His solo shows include John Pence Gallery, San Francisco in 2004; Eleanor Ettinger Gallery, New York, 2006; John Pence Gallery, 2008 and The Grenning Gallery, Sag Harbor, 2010. In 2003 he began teaching at the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts where, in 2011 he became an Assistant Professor in the Certificate/BFA program. In 2012 he was named one of 25 Important Artists of Tomorrow by American Artist Magazine. In 2013 his work was included in the book Painted Landscapes, Contemporary Views by Lauren P. della Monica. His work has also been reproduced in periodicals including, American Artist Magazine, American Arts Quarterly, Art News, American Art Collector, International Artist Magazine and Art and Antiques.
