

In the Box: Terms And Conditions

Donating Artists

MFA introduces In the Box, a grab-box event where MFA Member Artists donate pieces sized to fit in one of the regular USPS Priority Mail Boxes. Patrons will purchase a mystery box which the artist or MFA will pack and ship in December. Donations from Members count this year as their donation to Collector's Choice.

Please read the entirety of this document. By donating work, you agree to all of the below terms and conditions.

Artwork

Artists may donate up to two pieces. Artwork must meet size requirements and be able to fit inside a large USPS Priority Mail Box. For sizes see: <https://www.easypost.com/usps-flat-rate-boxes-and-pricing>

If work is larger than the box size, but is foldable to fit In the Box, please use largest box size upon entry. Artwork does not need to be framed. Work donated is to be used by Maryland Federation for Art for fundraising purposes.

Exhibition

Artwork must be submitted by November 1st, 2020, to be part of In the Box 2020. A Preview Gallery will exhibit your piece and link to your website.

In The Box Event

Tickets to the virtual event will be sold for \$50 to the public, \$35 tickets to donating artists. Artists will be notified of their newest collector, if MFA has contact information.

On December 5th, MFA will host a virtual event and all ticket buyers will be randomly assigned a piece of artwork. If an artist pulls their own number we will redraw for you.

Artists must either mail their artwork by December 15th, or drop the donation by Circle Gallery by December 10th and we will mail it for you.
