

NOCTURNE MAP



NOTES

- The Pop Up Gallery opens at 11 AM throughout the week of Paint Annapolis. The deadline to drop off work at the Pop Up Gallery is 4 PM Sunday through Thursday. The final deadline to drop off work is Friday, June 9 from 9 AM – Noon. Work must arrive already framed, wired, and ready to hang up at the Pop Up Gallery by Noon on June 9 to be considered for jurying. No exceptions.
- Refer to the maps included in this book or available on paintannapolis.org for the painting boundaries. Except as otherwise noted for Dueling Brushes and the Nocturne, artists may paint anywhere within the General Map.
- Artists will be notified by email or phone if their work sells.

Saturday, June 3

• Scout out areas you would like to paint with the maps here and online.

Sunday, June 4

 Dueling Brushes will take place at the Susan B. Campbell Park at City Dock. Stamping for Dueling Brushes ONLY will be at Circle Gallery from 8 – 8:45 AM and at City Dock at 8:30 AM. Artists may paint in the Dueling Brushes Map starting at 9 AM and ending at 11 AM. Artists must be set up at City Dock by 11:15 AM with their completed and framed work. All artwork must be displayed on an easel (provided by the artist) by 11:15 AM at Susan B. Campbell Park to be considered for awards. Awards will be announced at 1 PM. Artwork will be exhibited and for sale at City Dock from 11:30 AM – 2 PM. Artists may deliver completed work to the Pop Up Gallery after 2:30 PM and get the rest of your canvases stamped from 2:30 – 4 PM at the Pop Up Gallery (4 Church Circle).

Monday, June 5 – Thursday, June 8

- Stamping will take place at the Pop Up Gallery from **11 AM 4 PM**.
- Artists may paint within the designated area anytime during the days and anywhere within the designated Nocturne area until dawn and after dusk.

Tuesday, June 6

 Paint the Bay Reception will take place at the Annapolis Maritime Museum (723 Second Street) from 6 – 8 PM after a day of painting for a reception sponsored by the Junior League of Annapolis, Inc. Wine and food will be provided, and artwork by the Juried Artists will be for sale. This reception is free and open to the public.

Wednesday, June 7

• Dinner Under the Stars will take place from **5** – **10 PM** on Wednesday. Artists are encouraged to take advantage of the lively atmosphere and paint their Nocturne tonight within the Nocturne map.

Thursday, June 8

- Art on the Avenue will see Maryland Avenue closed to traffic and opened to the artists for painting, sales, and jurying for a fun celebration in the street from 4 7:30 PM. This event is free and open to the public.
- Set your best painting showcasing the architecture of Historic Annapolis up on an easel by **5:30 PM** to be considered for awards.

Friday, June 9

- **Drop off** is from **9 AM Noon**. All work must be turned in to the Pop Up Gallery no later than **Noon today**. You may drop off work as you finish it throughout the week, but only two pieces and a Nocturne can hang in the Pop Up Gallery for jurying. **No late work will be accepted**. **Work must arrive framed and wired for hanging. No exceptions**.
- Join us for the **Collector's Party** at the **Pop Up Gallery** from **6 8 PM** to see which of the Juried Artists won what awards, and to be the first to get a sneak peek at all of the works created throughout the week. Tickets may be purchased online at paintannapolis.org or at the door for \$25.

Saturday, June 10

- The Paint Annapolis Exhibitions are officially open! See the work in-person at the **Pop Up Gallery** from **11 AM 4 PM** everyday through **June 21**.
- Join us tonight for the Paint Annapolis Opening Reception at the Pop Up Gallery from 5 – 7 PM. Awards for the Public and Student Artists will be announced at 6 PM. This event is free and open to the public.

Sunday, June 11

• Muffins and Mimosas will be served at both galleries from **11 AM – 2 PM**.

Wednesday, June 21

 The Paint Annapolis Closing Reception is your last chance to view the work by the Public and Student Artists. Join us at the Pop Up Gallery from 5 – 7 PM. This event is free and open to the public.
